

Binance CEO Wants to Help Elon Musk Bring Twitter to Web 3.

Changpeng Zhao, the founder of Binance, the world's largest cryptocurrency exchange by trading volume, has announced his willingness to help new Twitter owner Elon Musk, bring the social media platform into Web3. In an Oct. 31 interview with CNBC's Squawk Box, CZ said there are many reasons to support the deal in which Binance invested \$500 million in Musk's purchase of Twitter.
